What we are looking for?

- What type of material is it?
- What size are the bales?
- Can we move the material directly to a mill?
- Are the bales neat?
- Are the bales uniformed?

Pricing your Commodity

- Pricing is based on supply and demand for your commodity
- Pricing is based on the Yellow Sheet for some commodities. Mainly OCC and News.
- Pricing comes out the first Thursday of each month.
- Pricing is based on 40,000 lbs. minimum
- Single grade shipments
- Mill direct shipments only

How pricing is determined with the yellow sheet?

- Supply and demand based
- Information gathered monthly from mills and suppliers
- Export vs. Domestic
- Different parts of the country have different prices for each regions

Specs on Material

- All Specification guidelines are created through I.S.R.I. The Institute of Scrap Recycling Industries, Inc.
- Mills also have there specifications as well

Shipping your Material Safely

- Each mill is responsible for there loading patterns and shipments
